

The Dal Paso Museum



Housed in a restored 1926 two-story brick hotel named for being the nicest hotel between Dallas and El Paso, the museum features home furnishings, pioneer tools, and ranch and farm equipment from the early days of settlement. Also on exhibit is work by local artists.

The museum is open Saturday from 2:00pm - 5:00pm. It can also be viewed Monday thru Friday 9:00am - 4:00pm by coming to the Chamber of Commerce office located next door.

The main floor of the museum and kitchen are available to rent for gatherings.
